### Rules & Regulations

Games will be 1 hr. 15 min. with three 20 minute running time periods. Full gear is required including a HECC approved helmet. (A FULL shield is required in Bronze League). (We strongly recommend that all players wear full face protection) **Players or Teams who clearly do not belong at the level they are playing will be moved to the appropriate level at any time, at the discretion of the league administration.**

The Sherwood Adult Hockey League strongly supports **ZERO TOLERANCE** in regards to our referees. They are a huge part of the success of our Adult Hockey League we thank them, and you should too.

**Fighting will not be tolerated.**

**First offense will carry a suspension from the game you are in, plus the next game; along with a \$25.00 fine**

**Second offense will result in a \$50.00 fine and a three game suspension.**

**Third offense EXPULSION FROM LEAGUE.**

**All misconduct penalties will be assessed a \$15.00 fine.**

**3 misconduct penalties in a season carry a 1 game suspension and a \$25.00 fine.**

**All fines must be paid in full before the fined players next game.**

**Team Rep fines are DOUBLE**

**Rosters will be LOCKED after game number 10.**

All suspensions carry over to the next season the suspended player participates in.

All fines collected will be placed in a fund to support the Sherwood Ice Arena Learn to Skate Program Scholarship Fund.

### Player Evaluations

Players will be evaluated for the league in our Adult Hockey Skills program on Thursday nights at 6:20pm, If you are a player who would like to join the league and have no idea were you belong, you must attend an Adult Skills class and be evaluated. Cost is \$17. If you sign up for the league the night of your evaluation the \$17 class fee will be waived.

## **RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS, INDEMNIFICATION, AND ARBITRATION AGREEMENT**

Notice – By signing this document you may be waiving certain legal rights, including the right to sue.

### Release and Waiver of Claims; Indemnification Agreement

In consideration of being allowed to participate in ice hockey programs (“Programs”) at Sherwood Ice Arena (the “Facility”), the Participant, do hereby agree, to the fullest extent permitted by law, as follows:

1) **TO WAIVE ALL CLAIMS** that they have or may have against the Facility arising out of the Participant’s participation in the Programs and/or the use of any equipment provided by the Facility (“Equipment”). The Participant specifically understand that they are releasing any and all claims that arise or may arise from any negligent acts or conduct of the Facility, its owners, affiliates, operators, employees, agents, and/or officers.

2) **TO ASSUME ALL RISKS** of participating in the Programs and using the Equipment, even those caused by the negligent acts or conduct of the Facility, its owners, affiliates, operators, employees, agents, and/or officers. The Participant understand that the risks of participating in the Programs and using the Equipment may be both foreseen and unforeseen and include serious physical injury and/or death;

3) **TO RELEASE** the Facility, its owners, affiliates, operators, employees, agents, and/or officers from all liability for any loss, damage, injury, death, or expense that the Participant (or his/her next of kin) may suffer, arising out of his/her participation in the Programs and/or use of the Equipment; and

4) **TO INDEMNIFY** the Facility, its owners, affiliates, operators, employees, agents, and/or officers, from all liability for any loss, damage, injury, death, or expense that the Participant (or his/her next of kin) may suffer, arising out of participation in Programs and/or use of the Equipment.

### Arbitration

The Participant hereby agrees to submit any dispute arising from participation in the Programs to binding arbitration. For such disputes, there shall be a three-member arbitration panel, consisting of two party-appointed arbitrators (one arbitrator to be appointed by each party) and one neutral arbitrator (collectively, the “Panel”), to be chosen by the party-appointed arbitrators. In the event that the two party-appointed arbitrators are not able to agree on a third, neutral arbitrator, the neutral arbitrator shall be appointed by the United States District Court, for the District of Oregon. Each party shall pay its own costs, including the costs associated with the party-appointed arbitrators, and the parties shall share equally the costs associated with the neutral arbitrator. The arbitration proceeding shall proceed in Sherwood, Oregon, and shall be governed by the Federal Rules of Evidence. The Panel shall establish a reasonable and appropriate discovery schedule to expeditiously resolve this matter.

The Participant understands that he/she is obligated to follow the rules of the Programs and that he/she can minimize his/her risk of injury through the exercise of common sense and by being aware of his/her surroundings.

If, while participating in the Programs, the Participant observes any unusual hazard, which he/she believes jeopardizes his/her personal safety or that of others, he/she will remove himself/herself from participation in the Programs and immediately bring said hazard to the attention of the Facility.

**I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS AGREEMENT AND I AM AWARE THAT BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT I MAY BE WAIVING CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO SUE.**
